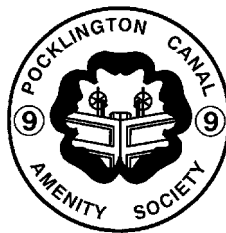

1. If your declaration covers donations you may make in the future:
 - ◆ Please notify PCAS if you change your name and address while the declaration is still in force
 - ◆ You can cancel the declaration at any time by writing to the PCAS Treasurer
2. You must pay an amount of income tax or capital gains tax at least equal to the tax that the charity reclaims on your donations in the tax year (currently 25p for each £1 you give)
3. If your circumstances change and you no longer pay sufficient tax on your income and/or capital gains, you can cancel your declaration (see Note 1)
4. If you pay tax at the higher rate, you can claim additional tax relief in your Self-Assessment Tax Return
5. If you are unsure whether your donations qualify for Gift Aid tax relief, please contact PCAS for advice or ask your local tax office for leaflet IR113 *Gift Aid*
